## Form

In the first half of the season:

- won 2 (Wood FC & Rezatec) and lost 6. A 25% win rate.
- scored 8 goals (ave. 1/game) and conceding 28 goals (ave. 3.5/game).

In the second half of the season:

- won 3 (Wood FC & Rezatec, and the Deportivo forfeited game) , drew 3 and lost 2. A 37.5% win rate or 75% non losing.
